Observership is an exclusive yearlong program for committed young professionals (in their 20s – 30s) who want to take their leadership to the next level.

Through a placement on a UJA-Federation allocating committee or a partner nonprofit board, Observers get a front row seat to the impact lay leaders have in shaping the community of tomorrow. Observers will learn from philanthropic leaders, understand issues facing the community, witness the funding process, and take part in the conversation.

Ultimately, this experience is the springboard to developing new skills and pursuing philanthropic passions at UJA and beyond.
